

Hair, Makeup & Costume

Makeup:

Students may wear light or heavy stage makeup; heavy makeup is preferred for better visibility on stage. Please choose colors that complement your child's skin tone.

Little dancers ages 3 to 6yrs old should wear little to no makeup.

Hair/ Costume accessories :

- **Pre Ballet, Ballet, & Jazz:** Low bun with a middle part (**Ballet shoes, Jazz shoes, tights**)
- **Tumbling:** Low bun with a middle part (**Bare feet**)
- **Hip Hop:** High ponytail (**Hip-hop or all black sneakers**)
- **Teen Contemporary:** Low bun with a middle part (**footsies**)
- **Mini Company:** Low bun with a middle part (**Jazz shoes, tan tights**)
- **Teen Company:** Low bun with a middle part (**tan tights, footsies**)
- **Elite Team:** **TBA**

Please ensure hair is neat, secure, and held in place with gel, hairspray, and bobby pins as needed.

Costume:

Dancers must arrive wearing their costume. If your child is participating in more than one dance, we will send you an email indicating which costume they should arrive in first.

Costumes should be steamed or ironed and wrinkle-free. Tutus should be puffed out to maintain their shape and fullness. Hair accessories that come with the costume should be placed on the right side of the head.

Dance Bag Must Include:

- All costumes if they perform in multiple dances
- All required shoes for each dance
- Any additional costume accessories (earrings, gloves, hats, etc.)
